I used to wash my vehicles by hand. That involved getting out a hose, bucket, suds, and a long-handled brush. Then I was introduced to the automatic car wash. Wow! It makes my life so much easier and now I am addicted to it. I drive up, the car goes through a series of rollers, suds coming down, water sprays the vehicle, a liquid wax is applied, power streams of air dry the car, and then I am done. What used to take half an hour of work is how accomplished in a couple of minutes and I did not lift a finger.

Our homes are also full of electric gadgets such as WIFI thermostats, washing machines, dishwashers, and robotic vacuum cleaners. This lifestyle in America has spoiled us. In previous generations, it might have taken the wife a couple of hours to prepare a dinner, but now we can get food on the table in just minutes. This has created a sense of instant expectation to have our needs met quickly and efficiently.

Undoubtedly, this lifestyle also affects what we believe when it comes to prayer. I do not really like the word "prayer," but it is the word associated with "talking with God." Most people do not expect to get an answer to prayer. To them it is a religious custom that is done in church. As a result, these people never receive an answer from God with their ritual. Then there are the more serious Christians who like to talk to God. But if they do not see immediate result, they give up and say it is useless talking to Lord.

# THE STATION WAGON

Let me give you an example dating back to 2005. I was driving and old Mercury Sable station wagon and it spent more time in the repair shop than on the road. I started talking to God that I wanted to get a better car and this went on for a good year. I kept talking and talking and I felt that God was not paying attention to me. Aina was driving a Volvo and I wanted one too. The model I liked was a XC-70 and I started talking to God about the car that caught my eye.

A married couple in Chico, California purchased a brand-new 2004 Volvo X-70 station wagon with every option. After driving it for two years, they decided to trade it in for a Land Rover. In the meantime, one of my radio listeners decided I needed a new car. I never talked to him about it and he stipulated in his will that \$20,000 be sent to me as a gift. His death coincided with this couple's decision to trade in their Volvo. They drove 150 miles south to a Land Rover/Porsche dealer in Rocklin. This was an upscale dealership that did not want a station wagon in their inventory. As a result, the price set for this 2-year-old car was \$25,000, which had originally sold for \$40,000.

In the meantime, I had talked to a good friend named Ove, who was an expert on Volvo cars, and I had told him what I was seeking. The Volvo X-70 was sitting on the lot a week since it had been traded in. Ove went to that particular dealership in the afternoon because he needed a part and saw the station wagon that I wanted. The price had been dropped to \$20,000 to induce it to sell quickly.

The next day I drove to the church building for a counseling session and planned to be there for most of the day. Ove called my home phone and told Aina about the car. He said it was a "steal" and we should act on it immediately. When I got to the dealership later in the day, the price was listed as \$25k. When I questioned the salesman about the discrepancy, he told me they would honor the lower price since I knew about it. Ove and I took the X-70 for a test ride and made the purchase. As I sat in the car on my way home, I could not help but praise God for answering my request.

I had been talking to God on and off for two years about a new car and receiving no answer. As I sat in the vehicle, I knew that from the first day that He had moved upon the Chico couple to purchase the \$40k car I wanted but could not afford it. The

God never told me that He was working on it. He wanted me just to trust Him. I kept reminding Him from time to time that I needed a new car and He lovingly ignored me while the details were worked out. I still drive this Volvo today and I have put 130,000 miles on it. It looks just a nice as when I bought it and I ride like a King's kid.
