
The important thing is to fill yourself with the Word of God to become strong and mature or other evil spirits will come back and it will be seven times worse.

STEPS TO LIVE A HOLY LIFE

- 2. The apostles made a decision to live a holy life but it was not until they had been baptized in the Holy Spirit that they had the power to do so. Acts 1: 4-8; 2:1-4

- 3. You must allow the Holy Spirit to live through you. Romans 8:1-17
- 4. Make the Bible a priority in your life as you study, meditate and live by it. Isaiah 55:7-12; Hebrews 4:12
- 5. In regards to every conversation, relationship and activity, would Jesus approve and be happy with it?
