PART 2: THE GREATNESS OF CHRIST

Paul identifies himself and to whom the letter is addressed. Ephesians.1:1

He speaks a blessing to his readers. verse 2

Then he blesses our heavenly Father. verse 3

PREDESTINATION

The apostle Paul had a deep understanding that God is eternal with no beginning or end. Paul is also brings out the concept that God has lived in a different dimension for eternity and that He is not bound by time. Before God began the creation we live in, He set forth the entire salvation process in Christ. verses 4-9; John 1:1-14; Romans 8:28-30

THE RELATIONSHIP OF THE FATHER AND THE SON

Paul wanted the Christians in Ephesus to know the relationship between God the Father and God the Son. **verse 10**

This relationship is stated even more clearly in his letter to the church in Corinth. **1 Corinthians 15:22-28**

THE INHERITANCE OF THE CHRISTIANS

A believer in Christ has received an inheritance. Ephesians 1:11

Paul gives more details in his letter to the church in Rome. Romans 8:15-18

TRUSTING AND SEALED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

Christians are to bring praise to God through their lives. **Ephesians 1:12**

The reason for this is that we have trusted in Christ for our salvation and been sealed by the Holy Spirit. **verses 13-14**

EXHORTATION BY PAUL

Paul gives thanks for the faith of the saints in Ephesus. verses 15-16

That the people will receive wisdom. verses 17-18

The mighty working power of God. verses 19-20

That Jesus is the head of the universal church. verses 21-23

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
