WHO IS IN CHARGE OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

Jesus is the King in the Kingdom of God. **Ephesians 1:15-23**

The wonderful news is that Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to be in charge of the Kingdom of God on the earth. **John 16:7-15**

The apostles continued to move in the authority given them by Jesus after the Day of Pentecost.

When Peter and John encountered a lame man, they used the name of Jesus to release the power of God to heal the man. **Acts 3:1-10**

When Peter encountered lying in the church, he moved in the Holy Spirit and spoke death to the liars. **Acts 5:1-11**

The entire church moved in the power of the Holy Spirit when Peter was arrested and was going to be put to death. **Acts 12:1-17**

The leaders were given divine guidance through prayer and fasting. Acts 13:1-3



When he met resistance from the enemy, Paul exercised the kingdom power and destroyed the opposition. **Acts 13:6-12**

Paul called out a healing in the power of the Holy Spirit. **Acts 14:8-10**

When Paul encountered a poisonous serpent, he stood on the Word of God. **Acts 28:1-6**

THERE IS A PROXY WAR
