POSITIVE THINKING

People do not generally like to hear anything negative and the system of sales is set up to motivate the consumer to buy a special product that will make him happy and fulfill all his needs in a specific area without warning him of the dangers of using the product. Let me give you a couple of examples:

- For the liquor producers, it's all about fun; they don't tell their customers about the danger of liver cirrhosis or the consequences of driving impaired.
- Food corporations never warn their consumers about the risk of obesity, heart attacks, strokes and blood clots.

Regardless of the product being sold, it is always advertised in a positive way with no warning of possible side effects or the results of abuse. The only exceptions are the tobacco and drug industry which are required by law to warn their customers about side effects.

THE GOSPEL MEANS GOOD NEWS

Christians are mandated by our Saviour to share the good news of salvation for the sinner who will repent and the eternal life we will have with God after we die. Jesus did not only tell the good news, He also came with demands that most Christians don't want to hear.
