PART 9: A STRONG FOUNDATION

BLESSINGS AND CURSES

Paul explains that a believer in Christ is blessed by God while an unbeliever is cursed. **Hebrews 6:7-8**

Paul expected great things from the Jewish believers in Christ. verses 9-12

A STRONG FOUNDATION

Paul referred to the covenant God made with Abraham. **verse 13**; **Genesis 12:1-**3; **22:15-18**

Notice that Paul did not tie this in with the nation of Israel; it is a covenant and blessing to the seed of Abraham, which is through faith in Jesus Christ. **Hebrews** 6:14-15; Romans 4:1-5

God cannot lie and the covenant of salvation can never be voided; there is nothing that can change that. God did not depend upon anyone to settle this covenant because it was made by Himself to Himself. **Hebrews 6:16-18**

This is an anchor for every believer in Christ since this anchor is lodged in heaven itself. **verses 19-20**

GOD'S WORDS ARE IRREVOCABLE

Once God has spoken, He will never change what he has spoken. **Isaiah 45:21-25**; **46:9-13**

God's words will never fail. Isaiah 55:8-11

We can trust the Bible to lead us into spiritual truth and eternal salvation because God does not change or retract His words. **Matthew 5:17-19**

The Constitution of the United States can be amended but the words of God can never be modified; God spoke perfection and there is no need for change. Man's thoughts and speech are flawed because we are not perfect like God, who will never lower His standard to fit the majority of people; instead, people will have to meet His standard or perish. **John 14:6**

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
