RESIST THE ENEMY

The German army quickly rolled over the allied armies of France, Belgium and England in May of 1940. The defeated British army and a remnant of the French army found themselves holed up in the coastal city of Dunkirk, and through the intervention of God, a flotilla of British navy ships, small fishing boats and pleasure crafts carried 199,000 British soldiers and 140,000 French soldiers to safety in England.

France was overtaken by Germany and the British army lost all its equipment in the hasty retreat. Prime Minister Winston Churchill faced a difficult situation in even hoping to win the war with Germany, but foremost, how could he fend off a German attack on Great Britain? History tells us that it was through hard work and the dedication of men and women that they were able to stop the Germans from invading, and with the help of the United States, they were able to go on the attack, invade France and eventually smash the German war machine.

A SPIRITUAL WAR
