PART 5: MORALITY 101

INTRODUCTION

NAME OF GOD

We are not to use the name of the Lord as a curse word. Exodus 20:7

Saved and unsaved people alike use the names of God and Jesus Christ as curse words. The Holy Spirit is insulted when people Christianize their curse words and cry out, "Holy Cow," "Gosh" and "Golly" for God, "Gee Wiz" for Jesus Christ, and "dang it" instead of "damn it."

Jesus commanded that our speech should be simple with no double talk. **Matthew** 5:33-37

God is holy and the Creator; He is supreme to all beings and to be worshiped in Spirit and in Truth. **John 4:21-24**

God is to be loved, respected and revered. Revelation 4:1-11
