PART 13: FAITH & HEALING

NO CONDEMNATION

The first verse has been misread by countless preachers who teach there is no condemnation as long as Christians do not walk in sin. That is a misrepresentation of what Paul said. There is only one way to be in Jesus and that is to be saved.

People who are not born again are subject to the Law of Death because they live in the flesh. Christians have had their dead spirits born again and they are now walking in the Holy Spirit.

There is no condemnation to those who are born again because the Law of Death does not apply to them. **Romans 8:1-2**

THE TORAH LAWS WON'T SAVE YOU

God's laws given to Moses (the Torah) cannot save you. Only Jesus, the Son of God, can pay for the sins of mankind, but in order to do so, he needed a body in the likeness of men. **verse 3**

Even after salvation, it is impossible to produce righteousness. Jesus fulfilled the righteousness of the Torah (Law of Moses) and we are clothed with the righteousness of Christ. **Romans 8:4**; **3:23-26**

Unsaved people will be carnally minded. Romans 8:5

If you are born once, you will die twice; if you are born twice, you will only die once. Being unsaved leads to death while faith in Christ leads to peace and eternal life. **verse** 6

The mind of an unsaved person is at war with God because it does not conform with the Laws given to Moses. It is impossible to do so without being born again. **verse 7**

People who are not saved cannot please God. verse 8

Any person who is born again has the Holy Spirit dwelling in them. A person who does not have the Holy Spirit is not saved. **verse 9**

When a person is saved, the dead spirit is born again and the soul is redeemed. The physical body does not change and is still subject to the Law of Death and will die one day. **verse 10**

THE RESURRECTION POWER

The Holy Spirit raised the dead body of Christ three days after the crucifixion. Jesus had spent three days and nights in Paradise, which is located next to hell under the surface of the earth. Luke 23:39-43; Luke 16:19-23; 1 Peter 3:18-20

The Holy Spirit resurrected Jesus' dead body early in the morning and He returned from Paradise and entered into his refurbished physical body. **Matthew 28:1-7**



The same resurrection power that surged through the dead body of Jesus is coursing through the physical bodies of every believer in Christ. **Romans 8:11**

We can receive physical healing through Jesus as long as we live on earth. God has guaranteed the physical body to last 120 years. **Genesis 6:3**

This guarantee is backed by Jesus. Isaiah 53:1-5; Matthew 8:16-17; 1 Peter 2:24

The apostle Peter confirmed the gift of health. Acts 3:1-16

A believer in Christ should accept this fantastic offer that is part of the salvation package and begin proclaiming that you are healed by the stripes on Jesus and that you do not have to be sick and feeble because of the power of the Holy Spirit surging through your body! **Romans 8:12-13**

FAITH IS MANDATORY

There is an old song that states "Prayer is the key to heaven, but faith unlocks the door." This is a great theological statement that we should quote every day. All the promises of God must be received in faith and there is no move by the Holy Spirit without faith.

There is no place in the Bible where it states you must be sick in order to die. Each Christian should declare, "I am going to die healthy!" **Hebrews 11:1-6**

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
