PART 25: CHRISTIAN CONDUCT

SYMPATHIZE

Rejoice and weep with people. Romans 12:15; Psalm 33:1-4; 35:13-14; Luke 1:56-58

LIKE MINDED

Christians are to be like minded. Romans 12:16a; 15:5-7; 1 Corinthians 1:10-13; Philippians 2:2-5

DON'T BE A SNOB

Be not high minded, but approach people of lesser statue. Romans 12:16b; Psalm 131:1-3; Proverbs 3:5-8; Isaiah 5:21

DON'T BE CONCEITED

Do not live in vanity of egotism, telling others how wise you are. Romans 12:16c; 2 Chronicles 7:14-15; 34:22-28

DON'T TAKE VENGENCE

Do not pay back evil with evil. Romans 12:17a; Hebrews 10:30-31; Proverbs 20:22

BE HONEST

Work hard and be honest, do not steal. Romans 12:17b; Proverbs 6:6-11; 2 Corinthians 8:21; 1Thessalonians 5:15; Exodus 20:15

BE PEACEFUL

Try to live at peace with all men. Romans 12:18; Hebrews 12:14

LOVE YOUR ENEMY

Be nice to your enemy and heap burning coals on his head. Romans 12:19-21; Proverbs 25:21-22; Matthew 5:44
