SPIRITUAL EFFORT

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THE BEGINNING

- ❖ Paul was grieved over the fact that an evil spirit promoted the Kingdom of God. Acts 16:16-18
- ❖ The seven sons of Sceva recognized there was power associated with the name of Jesus but the situation got out of control when they misappropriated His name. Acts 19:11-20

STAND IN THE GAP

Can you imagine if Jesus had been careless and apathetic during His 3.5 years of ministry? But this isn't the example He provided. Jesus humbled Himself and took the form of a man, allowed agents of Satan to abuse Him and died on the cross so we can have eternal life. Philippians 2:5-11

Most Christians are inwardly focused on health, relational and/or financial issues.
