PART 9: EMOTIONS AND CHOICES

GOD HAS EMOTIONS

Few people have grasped the fact that man is made in the image of God. **Genesis** 1:26-27

Human beings are triune just like God. This means you have a body, soul and a spirit. **Hebrews 4:12**

God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit are one but they also have the ability to operate as three entities. An example of this is would be when Jesus was on earth, God the Father was in heaven and the Holy Spirit connected them. **John 5:17-23**; **John 14:6-11**

LEARNING TO KNOW GOD

The Book of Jeremiah is a rich source of learning as to how God thinks, what He desires of people and what He likes to do. God revealed Himself to the people of Judah and told them they would not be cast out from the land if they repented and returned to Him. **Jeremiah 4:1**

God wanted a commitment from the people. verse 2

Remove the sinful lifestyle and do not plant among the weeds. verse 3

God's promise to Judah: if your repentance is genuine and you change your way of living, you will not be subject to my wrath. **verse 4**

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
