EVIL SPIRITS WORKING IN SECRECY

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PART 7A: PRINCIPALITY OF REJECTION

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There is nothing as devastating for a child as the loss of belonging, to be loved and cared for by a father and a mother. When a child is rejected, it creates a huge cancer-like wound in the soul which spiritually is bleeding profusely. Just like a mosquito can smell a human body a long distance away, so do evil spirits smell a rejected child, and descend upon that child with a vengeance and the Principality of Rejection firmly plants himself in that person. Rejection will bring in thousands of other spirits, including Bitterness, Jealousy and Envy, each principality having thousands of demons under their command. **Mark 5:1-20**

A rejected child has also lost the feeling of being respected! This is what happened to Cain; God had no respect to Cain's offering and rejected it! **Genesis 4:5**

A young child cannot help if they are rejected by loved ones; Cain was an adult when he was rejected by God. But the result is the same, *rejection always brings fierce anger*. **Genesis 4:6**

Cain knew that all his other sisters and brothers had lost all respect for him, and he pleaded with God to protect him. **Genesis 4:13-16**

Understand this important truth: God is not a respecter of persons; he treats all people the same! Acts 10:34-38; Romans 2:8-16

Most people who have been rejected, have lost all self-respect, and therefore cannot respect others. This creates more rejection, which in term creates a devastating damage to a person's self-image. If you cannot love yourself, neither can you love another human being. **Matthew 22:35-40**

Therefore, people with a rejection wound cannot love and respect other people, thus they are not able to fulfill the commandment of Jesus! **Matthew 5:44-48**

A person who does not feel that other people respect them, in turn do not respect other people, but demand respect for themselves! This creates anger and hate in all people involved. **James 3:11-18**

No person can demand respect! Respect is earned, not demanded! A husband demands respect from the wife, and since she does not respect the husband, she is not going to give it. In turn she will demand respect from the husband, who in his turn does not respect the wife, so he refuses to give it. The result, another blow up, with cries for divorce and yelling, "I don't have to take this any longer!"

If people have been through deliverance, they have added another club to their collection of weapons: "You are full of demons! Let me cast out your demons!"



Jesus has some wise words for warring spouses, and you will find them in **Matthew 7:1-5**.

HOW TO MOVE INTO VICTORY AFTER YOUR DELIVERANCE

- 1. Start reading **Matthew 18:21-35** and meditate day and night upon how much God forgave you and how little evil other people have done to you by comparison. As you have been forgiven, forgive and forget!
- 2. Recognize that you and others around you are sinners, saved by grace, and that no man is able to heal you or meet your craving needs of respect, acceptance and love. Only God can meet these needs, and when we look for this in other people, they will become frustrated and angry because it is not in them to give it to you. Do not make your spouse into a god with a small "g". **Exodus 20:1-6**
- 3. Do not seek approval from people. They will only hurt you. Seek approval from God only, *He is your only source for all things in life!* **Deuteronomy 28:1-15**
- 4. Do your best and then rest in God, regardless what others are screaming around you. **Matthew 6:24-34**
- 5. The spirit of Rejection brings in the spirit of Fear: Fear of Man, Fear of Failure, and Fear of more Rejection. Bathe yourself in the love of God and reject all spirits of Fear. 1 John 4:15-21
- 6. Proclaim your victory in Christ Jesus! Romans 8:26-31
