Attitude and arrogance became characteristics of the Devil once he decided to rebel against God, he had no respect for God and did not want to honor Him any more. **Isaiah 14:12-14**

- □ In the Ten Commandments, God laid the foundation of the law of respect. Exodus 20:12
- □ Jesus clarified this law. Mark 7:6-13
- □ In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus with great clarity stated what has been called the Golden Rule. Luke 6:31
- □ Jesus went beyond the laws of the Old Testament and laid down a law contrary to human nature, we are supposed to love our enemies! Luke 6:32-38
- □ The apostle Peter gave us further insight on this law of respect. I Peter 2:9-21
- □ The apostle Paul also had insight to this truth. **Ephesians 6:1-9**
- □ He addressed the relationship in a marriage. **Ephesians 5:21-33**
- □ He set forth how relationships in the church out to function. I Timothy 5:1-4; Titus 2:1-15
- U We are to esteem others higher than ourselves. Philippians 2:1-3
- U We are to honor people older than ourselves. **Leviticus 19:32**
- □ We are not to despise poor or uneducated people. James 2:1-9; Proverbs 14:31

SUMMARY

- □ In order to have good relationships, there must be a mutual respect and honor among people.
- □ If a person has an attitude or superiority, they will become useless in the Kingdom of God. They can be likened to "loose cannons" rolling all over the deck of a ship.
