PART 2B: GOD HAS TWO KINDS OF WRATH

GOD HAS TWO KINDS OF WRATH

Before and after the cross, God is a God of love, but there will come a time when He will not extend any more mercy to His people. God's wrath against His people has two purposes, to bring them back into repentance, and to let unbelievers know that sin will not go unpunished.

GOD'S WRATH AGAINST UNBELIEVERS

This wrath from God has no redemptive purpose, it is destructive and its purpose is to eradicate the people who have rebelled against the Lord. The first example of this is found in Genesis 6:1-13 . For some 100 years, Noah had been preaching repentance to the people living around him; but they rejected the message of God, and as a result, God rejected them.
God made an example of Pharaoh and his army when He drowned them in the Red Sea. There was no repentance for him and his army, only destruction and death! Exodus 14:13-31
There are many examples in the Old Testament of how God on a large scale exterminated armies and at time whole nations because of the wickedness of the people. There was no mercy or grace, just death and destruction. 2 Kings 19:32-37

THE JUDGMENT SEAT OF CHRIST

This is the time that God will do a final judgment on His people, where punishment will be meted out prior to the Marriage Feast of the Lamb, and where eternal positions and rewards will be given to each believer. 1 Corinthians 3:11-15; 2 Corinthians 5:9-11
