	The word "single" at the time the King James Bible was translated meant "honest, sincere, or seeing justly."	
	Demons can place an object far away from the person, where they cannot smell, hear, touch or taste the object, yet the eye will pick it up and send the image to the soul for evaluation. We have two prime examples of this recorded in the Bible:

MAKING THE RIGHT CHOICE

Remember, Satan and his fallen angels are limited when it comes to seducing and controlling a human soul. They can only move through the five senses but not attack the soul head-on. So when an evil spirit places an object of lust in front of you, he is able to read your mind and know what you are doing with the image projected before your soul. The soul can shield itself by refusing the signals coming in from the five senses, with eyesight being the hardest to guard, and so when you think to yourself, "I reject this in the name of Jesus," that demon has lost the opportunity to gain an entry to you.

However, if you begin thinking about the object and continue to look at it, the demon has the legal right to enter your body like a laser beam through your eyes. It will happen so quickly that you won't be able to feel or discern it. Once the demon is on the inside of you, he will entice you to go a step further by engaging the object and bringing it to your body so that the other four senses can begin to experience what the eye has seen. James 1:13-15
