COMMON THEME IN THE BIBLE

GOD EXPECTS US TO LISTEN AND OBEY

How can we be expected to listen and obey if we don't know what God expects of us? **Deuteronomy 6:1-9**

Jesus said that we would keep His commandments if we loved Him. **John 14:15**

Many people listen to what God has to say but they don't follow through with obedience. God has given us instructions on how to have an abundant life on the earth because our actions will dictate what happens now and the rewards, if any, we will receive in heaven.

- ❖ Adam and Eve ate of the forbidden tree. **Genesis 2:16-17**
- ❖ Terah was chosen by God but he stagnated in Haran and the responsibility went to Abraham. **Genesis 11:27-32; 12:1**
- ❖ King Saul was chosen by God but he didn't follow the instructions and lost the lineage to David. **1 Samuel 10:8; 13:8-14; 15:22-23**
- ❖ There is a lot of pain and suffering in the world because people refuse to listen and obey God. **Joshua 24:14-31**
- ❖ Israel was under a theocracy but they didn't obey God's commandments and every man did what he "felt" was right. **Judges 21:25**

God has a plan for your life; He will extend grace but that doesn't mean He won't hold you accountable for your actions.

STRENGTH IN OBEDIENCE

When Jesus was tempted by the Devil, it would have been easy to be distracted and respond back with an opinion rather than scripture. **Matthew 4:1-11**



Even though Jesus agonized in prayer just hours before the crucifixion and was tempted to walk away, it was because of His obedience that we can be born again. **Luke 22:42-46**

Walking with God and obeying His voice has its benefits. When you have been given a task, see that it reaches completion. Don't let your legacy be of someone who started but never finished. **Galatians 6:7-9**
