The apostle Paul encountered a sorcerer who tried to stop the Roman deputy from hearing the Gospel. Paul pronounced a curse upon him as a judgment from God and the man lost his eyesight for a season. **Acts 13:5-12**

As long as a person can be saved, we do not have the authority to ask God to kill that person, but the rules will change during the reign of the Antichrist for the people who have taken the Mark of the Beast. Any such person is forever damned and cannot repent. **Revelation 14:9-11**

Therefore, those who have taken the Mark of the Beast can be killed if they pose a threat. **Revelation 11:3-6**

LIVING THROUGH THE REIGN OF THE ANTICHRIST
