CHAPTER TEN

VERSE 1

When God created the angels, He created them to be powerful, with the ability to take whatever size needed for the task that is set before them. **Judges 13:1-21**

VERSES 2-3

VERSES 5-6

VERSE 7



VERSES 8-11
