	God spoke to Adam and told him not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. Genesis 2:15-17
	When Adam and Eve ate of the tree, how did God react? Genesis 3:16-24
	God had clearly laid out how he wanted the service at his altar but Nadab and Abihu tried their own program and God was not amused! Leviticus 10:1-11
