PART 7: LIVING IN DIVINE HEALING

This will be the last sermon in this series on *Understanding Divine Healing*. Having laid a foundation, we need to look at how a Christian should live, being healthy, victorious, and walking in obedience to God.

	THY DO WE HAVE DIVINE HEALTH? There are strong references in the Bible that divine healing is available to a child of God who has been born again. However, it is important to remember that nothing will happen unless we have faith, and faith can only come by the hearing of the Word of God. Romans 10:17
	Seven hundred years before Christ, God spoke to the prophet Isaiah. Isaiah 53:1-10, 61:1-3
	Jesus confirmed that the words recorded by Isaiah were indeed given to him from God. Luke 4:14-21; Matthew 8:1-17
	Some 60 years after the birth of Jesus, the Apostle Peter continued to confirm these words. 1 Peter 2:24
WI dis	HE MINISTRY OF THE APOSTLES then Jesus was here on the earth, He gave authority to the apostles and other sciples to cast out demons and to heal the sick. Matthew 10:1-9; Luke 9:1-5, 1:1-9, 17-22
HOW IT WORKED FOR THEM Let's look at some of the miracles that took place after Jesus had ascended to heaven:	
	When Peter and John encountered the lame man, without hesitation, they spoke a healing into existence. Acts 3:1-11
	The apostle Paul never saw Jesus in the flesh, but he did not hesitate when he encountered the impotent man. Acts14:7-18
	Paul had no problems dealing with demons or snakes. Acts 13:6-12, 16:16-19, 28:1-6
	THAT ABOUT YOU AND ME? Do we have a biblical foundation to stand upon? Is the power of God with us today as it was for the first generation of Christians? The answer is a resounding YES! Look at the following scripture: Matthew 28:18-20;

☐ We should believe and honor the words that Jesus spoke! John 14:1-18
