PART 8: ETERNAL SECURITY IN CHRIST

In the sixth chapter, the apostle Paul has moved on from the principles of the doctrine of Jesus Christ in order to make sure that the Jewish believers in Christ wouldn't continue to dwell solely on the basics. **Hebrews 6:1-3**

Paul wanted to destroy the thinking that a person could be saved more than once; he told the Jewish believers that "if" a person could fall away and lose his salvation, there would be no second provision. **verses 4-6**

ETERNAL SECURITY IN CHRIST

We are saved under the Second Covenant between God the Father and God the Son. **2 Corinthians 5:17-19**

Therefore, we should not look in the Old Testament for our security in Christ, but the New Testament, which is a testimony of the Second Covenant.

Paul stated that Christ is able to save to the uttermost. **Hebrews 7:25**

When is a person saved? Is it at the moment of repentance, or at the time of death, or perhaps sometime during a person's life? The Bible says that salvation takes place at the moment a person calls out to God and repents of his sins. **Romans 10:8-13; 1 John 5:10-13**

Eternal life with God is bestowed upon you when you repent. **John 10:27-30**

You are transferred from the kingdom of Satan into the Kingdom of God at the moment of salvation. **Colossians 1:12-14**


Taking the Mark of the Beast is the only act a saved person can take that will cause them to forfeit their salvation. **Revelation 14:9-13**

It is important to know the four Gospels and all the epistles of the New Testament were written before Jesus gave the apostle John the Book of Revelation. Therefore, none of the apostles knew about the Mark of the Beast.

Blaspheming the Holy Spirit is not done out of ignorance. The Jewish leadership had full knowledge and understanding that the miracle performed was the work of the Holy Spirit but they ascribed it to be the work of Satan. **Matthew 12:22-32**

Blaspheming the Holy Spirit is a sin that will not be forgiven on earth or in heaven but it does not refer to salvation.

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
