PART 13: THINKING SUPERNATURALLY

FACTS ABOUT THE END TIMES

This is the last message of this series and I want to clear up any misconceptions about the reign of the Antichrist and the Great Tribulation.

1. The “Reign of the Antichrist” is not the same time period as the “Great Tribulation.”
2. The Bible does not say there will be a catching away (rapture) of the Christians prior to the reign of the Antichrist.¹
3. The Great Tribulation described by Jesus will take place toward the end of the reign of the Antichrist and will be a judgment on the Antichrist and the people who follow him. **Matthew 24:21-22**

Some Christians living during the time of the Antichrist will refuse to take the Mark of the Beast and survive because God will supernaturally feed and protect His people. They will have the seal of God in their foreheads and be immune to the severe judgments that are carried out on the people who have taken the Mark of the Beast.

SUPERNATURAL WEAPONS FOR CHRISTIANS?

The apostle Paul said that our weapons are not carnal but supernatural. **2 Corinthians 10:3-6**

We can request an action from God but we do not pull the trigger so to speak. The action is carried out by the Holy Spirit and God’s holy angels. **John 14:9-18**

The prophet Elijah used a supernatural weapon to protect himself. **2 Kings 1:1-17**

The prophet Elisha represented God and did not tolerate those children mocking him. He cursed the children and two female bears came out of the forest and killed 42 of them. **2 Kings 2:19-25**

The apostles James and John were offended by Samaritans and wanted to retaliate. Jesus rebuked them and told them that He would not approve their unholy request. **Luke 9:51-56**

Jesus cursed a fig tree and it dried up from the root. **Mark 11:12-14; 20-26; Romans 5:6-11**

Jesus told the disciples that nothing was impossible for God when they prayed in His name, but there was a condition that had to be met before their prayers

would be answered. They can't harbor any unforgiveness and had to forgive everyone who had hurt them.

This meant they could also not harbor any unforgiveness toward themselves.

Self-hate, bitterness, resentment, regrets and not being able to love yourself will stop God from answering prayers. **verses 24-26**

It is important to walk in the light and abandon sin if you want God to hear your prayers and for Him to move in the supernatural on your behalf. **1 John 1:4-10**

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
