BLUEPRINT

Like a blueprint for a building, God saw you before you were created. He has a plan for every human being. **Jeremiah 1:4-5**

The problem is sin; it messes everything up. This is what happened with Adam and Eve and it was the second Adam (Jesus) that reopened the communication. Since the Garden of Eden, when the soul is attached to the physical body at the moment of conception, the connection with God is broken. **Ephesians 1:7-11**

It is necessary to get reacquainted with God. Colossians 1:12-14

BAD SITUATIONS

God doesn't expect great things right away when you come to Him. Like a newborn that only drinks milk, the Lord realizes you will need guidance and others to lean on for help, but eventually you need to eat solid foods and strike out on your own. **Hebrews 5:12-14**

The Israelites did not fully follow God's instructions when it came to driving out the inhabitants of Canaan. Those who remained in the Promised Land contaminated God's people with their idol worship and the Israelites vacillated between God and the demon gods. **Psalms 121:1-8**

God will create situations where you must depend upon Him:

- 1. The mishaps of King David.
 - a. Saul perpetually chased him. 1 Samuel chapters 21-31
 - b. Those plotting against him once he was king. Psalm 37:34-36
 - c. Absalom leading a revolt against him. 2 Samuel chapters 15-18
- 2. The fiery furnace of Nebuchadnezzar. Daniel 3:1-30
- 3. The den of aggressive lions. Daniel 6:1-28
- 4. Martha dealing with the premature death of her brother. John 11:1-45
- 5. Paul dealing with never ending persecution. 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

If God has placed you in a difficult situation, you won't get out of it until you begin communicating with Him. He doesn't want to you be dependent upon others. He will provide you with the solution when you turn to Him. **Matthew 11:28-30**

GOD IS THE SOURCE

God can communicate through a variety of methods such as prayer, scripture and personal revelation. He doesn't want you to become dependent upon other human beings or organizations; God can use them but you shouldn't come to rely upon them because the God of Creation wants to be your source. **Psalms 121:2**
