THE SPIRIT OF FEAR

Fear is a spirit and in the kingdom of Satan there are millions of such spirits of fear. They attack a person's intelligence and emotions. The Bible states that demons of fear are not from God. **1 Timothy 1:7**

The demon of fear brings torment. 1 John 4:18

The demon of fear activates selfishness in a person. A perfect example of this is the prophet Jonah.

- ❖ Jonah was told by God to go to Nineveh, the capitol of Assyria, and warn them of a coming judgment. Jonah 1:1-2
- ❖ Jonah hated the Assyrians because they had afflicted Israel with wars. He wanted God to kill the Assyrians and not give them a chance to repent. Jonah 4:1-2
- ❖ After unsuccessfully running away from God, Jonah finally delivered the message and decided to watch the city for when the Lord would strike the Assyrians because he didn't believe they would repent. Jonah wanted to be as comfortable as possible and built himself a temporary shelter. God responded and rapidly grew a gourd and used the leaves of the plant to provide Jonah with shade from the sun. Jonah 4:5-6
- ❖ God prepared a worm and it killed the gourd. Jonah was comfortable and thoroughly enjoyed his new dwelling place. He did not want any changes and any threat against the gourd made him angry and fearful. Jonah wanted comfort and did not care about the welfare of Nineveh. verse 7
- ❖ God upped the discomfort and sent a strong east wind that damaged the booth and the ultra violet rays of the sun struck the head of Jonah, who became very unhappy. verse 8
- ❖ God wanted to deal with Jonah and reveal his selfishness. Jonah cared about a little plant that gave him comfort but not for the 120,000 people who were about to be killed in a judgment from God. verses 9-11

SELFISHNESS

When the Soviet Union was dissolved on December 25, 1991, it was the greatest Christmas gift to the people living in Europe and the United States. The threat of nuclear war was over, and with time, the economies of the world started to grow and people were happy.

Instead of thanking God and getting involved in Christian churches, the people turned to entertainment, sports, vacations, cruises, etc. They wanted to upgrade their living



quarters and the housing industry exploded to meet the new demand for bigger and fancier homes.

Homosexuality which had been suppressed began to grow as people were deceived by the Devil and the rich and famous got into child pornography. Sado-masochism, sex perversion, and pedophilia¹ began to rise quickly.

Bars became a normal hangout for the people who went to drink and socialize.

Legalized gambling blossomed as people flew to Las Vegas and other gambling places to sample everything offered. There is no end to the sinful behavior found in these places.

The auto industry flourished as more people could afford to buy new cars, motor homes, travel trailers, boats, jet skis, snow mobiles, etc.

He eventually became counted as a leader in the church at Jerusalem.

Most likely there will be no repentance because the majority of pastors will not seek God and lead their flocks in repentance. They are stuck in their sins like the Israelites of old and doomed themselves to judgment. **Jeremiah 15:1-7**
