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PART 98: THE GREATEST STORY EVERY TOLD

A SUMMARY

I started a series on the Gospel of Matthew in 2020. I preached nine messages and realized something was missing in my effort to explain some of Jesus' seemingly bizarre decisions. The redemption story of humanity began thousands of years prior to the Gospel of Matthew.

In order to understand the purpose for the Son of God's incarnation and actions on earth, I felt it was necessary to return to the beginning of the redemption story, which started with the call of Terah, a Chaldean man from Ur, who had a business making figurines of demon gods.

- 1. Was there a pre-determined plan for the human race?
- 2. Was the coming of Jesus just a random act?

I will seek to answer these questions in this first summary message.

THE VIRTUAL TIME RUN

When I asked God to show me how to convey the redemption story, the Holy Spirit gave me a vision of a virtual time run. This was uncharted territory for me and the following is how I described it:

God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit have always existed. Thus, all spiritual laws have always existed as well. Spiritual laws govern relationships, obedience, and science. **Isaiah 55:8-11; Psalm 119:89; Matthew 5:17-19**

Sometime in eternity past, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit gathered around a massive supercomputer in the throne room of the third heaven. They wanted to create sentient beings that would choose to love them and this would necessitate endowing these beings with a free will or else it would be a false/artificial love.

The Godhead began by designing everything virtually and running a timeline to see how things would turn out. They wanted a physical universe to exist in a spirit world. They called these creatures "angels" and made them with the ability to operate in the spirit world as well as the physical world.

They saw that Lucifer would rebel and start a space war in the physical universe, the creation of Adam and Eve as a result of Lucifer's sin, and technology would



play a huge role on the refurbished earth. The Godhead was going to send Jesus as the Messiah to the earth and Lucifer would demand that for any action the Godhead took on earth, he would have the legal right to do the same thing.

Jesus was not going to set up a physical kingdom on earth and therefore did not need a high level of technology for its inhabitants. Holy angels were in charge of His security and the Holy Spirit would work on the souls of the people. Jesus did not want a control system; He wanted people to come of their own free will. They would have the choice to stay or to leave. **John 6:59-66; 18:36**

The Godhead ran the virtual time run to the point when Lucifer set up the Antichrist system and realized technology needed to be held back until the Luciferian control system was needed. Electricity would pave the way for developing additional technology on earth and the Godhead set that time to be around 1.5 days (1,500 years) after the resurrection of Jesus.¹

The virtual time run was completed to the end of the millennial kingdom, once the Godhead ensured their will would be done, they set the creation in motion.

THE TIME BEFORE ADAM AND EVE

The Holy Spirit led me further into unfamiliar territory when He directed me to teach on the time period prior to Adam and Eve. I would say that most of my Christian life I have held the common view that angels were created to glorify God, but they could not fulfill His desire for fellowship, hence the creation of the human race. To put it another way, God was lonely and mankind was created to fill the void.

I do not want to bring in teachings found outside of the Bible. To that intent, I have relied upon the King James Bible and the Books of Enoch (Ethiopian version) quoted by Jesus. Peter, and Jude.

The conclusion of this segment was that angels were the first thing Jesus created. They were holy and without sin. After the angels came the creation of the physical universe in which we reside. The angels were commissioned to populate the different planets of the universe and rule over what the Bible calls "people." The Scriptures do not reveal if Jesus created these people or whether angels performed the task. **Isaiah 14:12;18-20; Ezekiel 28:14-19**

The Bible does not disclose the length of this time period, and since none of the angels had bodies that decayed with age, this time period could have persisted for millions of years.

The Scriptures reveal there was a day when one of the most beautiful and powerful angels decided to rebel against God. He traveled throughout the universe to convince

the other angels to join his cause. One third of the angels sided with Lucifer and this resulted in a devastating space war. The destruction of this conflict touched the entire universe and ended when Lucifer and the other fallen angels were defeated and captured in our solar system.

A trial was held with Jesus presiding as judge. Lucifer and his minions were sentenced to the Lake of Fire. Lucifer objected to the harsh sentence and accused God of being unrighteous. In order to refute this spurious indictment, the Godhead created the human race to prove their righteousness. This led to the refurbishing of the earth and the creation of Adam and Eve. They were told to repopulate the earth. **Genesis 1:27-28**

THE BLOODLINE OF THE REDEEMER

The Godhead waited until Terah was born, some 1,878 years after the fall of Adam and Eve. He was a ninth-generation descendant of Noah who had forgotten what God had done some 200 years earlier with a global flood. Lucifer had removed the knowledge of Noah's flood and Terah had become a hard-core pagan worshiper. Terah had a lucrative business of making idols and his family was involved in this business in the city of Ur in Chaldea.

He must have had a strong encounter with Jesus because he packed up his business and family and moved north to Haran and set up a permanent home in what is today modern Iraq even though he had been told to go to the land of Canaan. The Son of God eventually abandoned Terah and called his son, Abram, to go to Canaan in his stead. Abraham was to walk with Jesus and start a family that would one day become a nation. He abandoned paganism to become a man of faith who personally interacted with the Son of God. **Hebrews 11:8-10**

SHELTERED IN EGYPT

Some 500 years later the offspring of Abraham were slaves in Egypt. The family had grown to more than three million and became known as the twelve tribes of Israel. There were interventions by Jesus prior to the exodus to ensure that Lucifer could not derail the redemption plan.

It is puzzling to think that the Hebrews were in Egypt for 430 years, but there is no written account of what took place during these years. The record keeping stops after the death of Joseph and does not pick up until the birth of Moses.

The selection of Moses and Aaron saw the battle for the bloodline intensify and it took supernatural plagues against the people of Egypt before Moses was allowed to lead the Hebrews to freedom. The next forty years were filled with supernatural intervention from Jesus and angels until the Israelites entered the Promised Land under the leadership of Joshua. **Joshua 1:1-7**

TRAGEDY OF THE HEBREWS

Few Christians have reflected on the fact that the Holy Spirit was only available as an anointing prior to the resurrection of Jesus. There was no baptism with the Holy Spirit as recorded in the Book of Acts. **John 7:37-39**

Divine guidance for the Hebrews came through direct contact with Jesus or holy angels. There were prophets that Jesus addressed directly, who in turn repeated the message to the masses. Jesus had only one option available when the people sinned and refused to repent – punishment!

The curse might come through a plague, a limited attack from an enemy, or being conquered by hostile nations. Every adult (20 years old and up) who came out of Egypt was sentenced to die by wandering in the wilderness. They were chastised for their unbelief and denied access to the Promised Land.

Moses disobeyed Jesus one time and struck the rock in anger when he was specifically instructed to speak to it. This one act disqualified even him from entering the Promised Land. **Deuteronomy 32:48-52**

Joshua and Caleb were the only adults from Egypt that made it into the Promised Land. **Numbers 14:27-30**

Severe punishment from famine, pestilence, and invasion by other nations was the way the Son of God governed the Hebrews until the incarnation.

It is a tragedy that only a remnant of the Hebrews opted to reject paganism and be saved. **Isaiah 10:22-23**; **Romans 9:27**

ENTERING THE PROMISED LAND

Going back to ancient times, the land of Canaan was the most demon infested territory in the world. Jesus told Abraham that when the iniquity of the Amorites had reached a certain limit, the Hebrews would enter and take it from them. **Genesis 15:16**

The Hittites, Girgashites, Amorites, Canaanites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites were seven nations living throughout the land of Canaan when Joshua and the Hebrews entered their borders. They were hardcore pagans who worshiped their demon gods with food and drink, sexual orgies (which included homosexuality), and burning children alive. They practiced incest and lived without morality.

Jesus instructed the Hebrews to cleanse the land and terminate every man, woman and child with extreme prejudice. Kill them all! **Deuteronomy 7:1-6**

This decree from the Son of God was never fully carried out and it doomed most of the Israelites as they succumbed to the wickedness and debauchery of the rituals of their pagan neighbors.

Remember, it's not so important how you begin your life after salvation, but how you finish it!
